



JERKO BRKIĆ WINS THIS YEAR'S ROAD TO UMAG BY PODRAVKA

This year's edition of Road to Umag by Podravka ends in a triumph by Jerko Brkić, a 24-year-old member of TK Split 1950. In the final stage of the Masters, a tournament played by four of the most successful players from three qualifying competitions, Brkić played a very even and suspenseful match ending in 7:5, 5:7, 12:10 against his team-mate Luka Mikrut and won the coveted award – a chance to play in the qualifiers for the main Plava Laguna Croatia Open Umag tournament.

Brkić got a spot in the Masters after winning the qualifying tournament in Karlovac. The first competition was held in Split, the second in Karlovac, and the third in Samobor. In addition to Brkić and Mikrut, Luka Curavić and Domagoj Bilješko also got a chance to play in Umag. In the semi-final matches, Mikrut won 6:1, 6:2 against Curavić, and Brkić won 3:6, 7:5, 10:5 against Bilješko.



This was the third edition of Road to Umag by Podravka, which has now become a tradition, and ever more popular among Croatian tennis players (the only ones eligible to compete) whose placement in the individual ATP rankings isn't high enough for them to participate in the professional ATP tournament qualifications.

"I would like to thank all of the clubs which participated in the organisation," said tournament director Tomislav Poljak. "It makes me happy that this series has become very popular, and I think it proved to be a great idea." The previous two editions were won by Matija Pecotić. In both cases, he came very close to placing in the main tournament, having gone through the first qualifying round, but he lost in the decisive second round. This year, Brkić was defeated 6:2, 6:2 at the start of the qualifying tournament by Kazakhstani Timofey Skatov.

QUALIFYING PLAYERS ROUND UP THE MAIN TOURNAMENT

The main tournament of this year's Plava Laguna Croatia Open Umag was rounded up on Sunday night, with the last qualifying match. Most successful players of the qualifiers were Jesper de Jong from the Netherlands, Facundo Bagnis from Argentina, Filip Misolic from Austria, and Flavio Cobolli from Italy, who won their second round matches and got the chance to participate in the main draw of the tournament.



De Jong won 6:2, 6:4 against Tomás Barrios Vera from Chile, after a match in which he lost only one serve (this was also the only break point his opponent had). Bagnis turned around his match against Timofey Skatov after the Kazakhstani won the first set and had an early break point advantage in the second. In the end, the match was won by Bagnis (5:7, 6:4, 6:2), who participated in the quarter-finals in Umag two times: last year he lost against Carlos Alcaraz from Spain, and in 2019 against Italian Salvatore Caruso.

Filip Misolic, Austrian player of Croatian descent, won 6:4, 6:3 against Damir Džumhur from Bosnia and Herzegovina.

His only break point in the first set came in the tenth game, and Džumhur was better at the start of the second set, taking a 3:1 lead. However, he didn't win any more games by the end of the match. Cobolli won 6:4, 6:2 against Zdeněk Kolář from Czechia, marking the first time he will be participating in the main tournament: he lost at the start of the qualifiers last year and the year before. At the end of the qualifying tournament, the main tournament draws were made for the main tournament.

Bagnis will face the 2015 winner of the Umag tournament, Dominic Thiem from Austria. Cobolli will play against the 2012 Umag champion, Croatian Marin Čilić, while De Jong will face the seventh seed, Matteo Arnaldi from Italy. Last but not least, Misolic will play against the 2006 Umag winner, Swiss player Stan Wawrinka.





GRAND SLAM CHAMPIONS FACING QUALIFIERS

The draw for this year's ATP Plava Laguna Croatia Open Umag took place in the Taste Istria zone under the watchful eye of the chief referee Gerry Armstrong, who has been performing this function on behalf of the ATP for almost two decades.

All three Grand Slam winners participating in this year's tournament - Marin Čilić, Stan Wawrinka, and Dominic Thiem - have drawn opponents from the qualifiers. Additionally, one Croatian tennis player will definitely advance to the round of 16, as Dino Prižmić and Duje Ajduković will face each other in the first round.

The top four seeded players will have a bye in the opening round and will join the action in the round of 16. These players are Lehečka from the Czech Republic (1st seed), Sonego from Italy (2nd seed), Ofner from Austria (3rd seed), and Carballés Baena from Spain (4th seed). In other words, their opponents will only be known after the completion of the first round.





"I'm happy to see Marin back here for the first time since 2014. Umag is more than a tournament, so I am expecting a lot of good matches next week. I'm looking forward to the matches, good performance by Croatian players, and seeing everyone there. Have a great time!
