





WAWRINKA SUCCESSFUL WITH GREAT SUPPORT FROM THE AUDIENCE



It was 19 years ago that Stan Wawrinka won his first ATP title in Umag, but two decades later, he can still play great tennis! At the 35th edition of the Plava Laguna Croatia Open on Monday, he overcame the first hurdle and defeated qualifier Alvaro Guillen Meza 6:4, 6:1. He didn't get off to a great start, as the Ecuadorian had a 2:1 lead and broke service in the early stages, but he quickly found the right rhythm and eventually reached his eleventh singles victory in Umag.

"The energy from the crowd was great. The atmosphere is great, it's a pleasure to play in such an environment. I'm always surprised by the support I have here," said Wawrinka, who has won one title at Stella Maris and another final appearance.

This season, however, he has not been particularly successful, so including this match, his win-loss ratio is 2:9. In total, he has won 16 major titles during his career, and among them stand out his triumphs at three different Grand Slam tournaments - the Australian Open, Roland Garros and the US Open. At one point, he was the third player in the world on the ATP singles ranking list, and throughout his career he defeated all the best players in the world. In the final of Umag 2006, he played against Novak Djokovic, who retired due to breathing problems.

Wawrinka will play against the qualifier on Wednesday as well, and his opponent will be Frenchman Titouan Droguet, 176th on the ATP ranking list. Among the players from the qualifiers, the Spaniard Pablo Llamas Ruiz, 537th on the individual ATP ranking list, had a successful day, coming back after an injury problem, and so far is doing well in Umag.

On Monday, the tournament was left without a former winner of this tournament, as Serbian Dušan Lajović was defeated by Frenchman Terence Atmane 6:3, 6:4. Lajović is currently 129th in the ranking list and not in the form of 2019, when he won the title in Stella Maris. Against Atmane (136th), he firmly held serve until 3:4 and then missed two break points, to immediately fight back. He led 3:1 in the second set, but the Frenchman won four games in a row after that. This is Atmane's first victory in major tournaments this season.

The main tournament continues on Tuesday, when the first round will be completed, but some of the round of 16 matches will also be played. In the singles competition, the first-round matches will be played by Mili Poljičak and Dino Prižmić. Mili (not before 18:00) will face the Dutchman Jesper de Jong, and Dino (not before 21:00) will face the Dane Elmer Moller. The tournament also begins for the third seed, Argentinian Camilo Ugo Carabelli, who awaits Italian Francesco Passaro.

LEGENDS AND THE BEST CROATIAN WHEELCHAIR PLAYERS COMPETE AT THE SIXTH EDITION OF THE TOURNAMENT IN UMAG



As part of the only Croatian ATP tournament, Plava Laguna Croatia Open Umag, the ITF Wheelchair Croatia Open Umag by HEP will be held again this year. The tournament is entering its sixth edition and, from July 24th to July 26th, the world's top wheelchair tennis players will once again gather on the courts of the Umag Tennis Academy and the ATP Centre in Stella Maris to compete for points on the ITF world rankings.

A total of 16 players from seven countries will compete in the tournament, with the top seed being Frenchman Geoffrey Jasiak, currently ranked 28th in the world. Alongside him, the Umag audience will also be introduced to former tournament winners – Polish Kamil Fabisiak, ranked 37th in the world, and Austrian Josef Riegler, ranked 69th , who has not missed a single edition of the tournament so far. Another big name in this year's edition is the legendary Austrian Martin Legner, ranked 52nd in the world and one of the most decorated players in the history of wheelchair tennis.

Croatia will be represented by its three best wheel-chair tennis players, Anto Joskić, currently ranked 70th in the world and also the tournament organizer, Sven Maretić, who is ranked 71st, and Ante Kolunđija, 89th in the world rankings.

"I am proud that the tournament is entering its sixth edition and that we will once again have the opportuni-

ty to watch top-notch wheelchair tennis here in Umag. We have a great competition, several renowned names and I believe that exciting matches await us. I would like to thank our sponsor HEP and the organizers of the Plava Laguna Croatia Open Umag for their exceptional cooperation and support," said Joskić.

From the very start, the goal of this tournament has been to raise awareness and visibility of sports for people with disabilities, and Umag is proving itself to be a great stage again this year. The tournament draw will take place on Wednesday, July 23rd in Stella Maris, and the matches will be played from Thursday, July 24th to Saturday, July 26th.





THE HUMANITARIAN ACTION "ACE TO THE RESCUE" IS BACK ON THE UMAG COURTS AT THE PLAVA LAGUNA CROATIA OPEN UMAG





At the Plava Laguna Croatia Open Umag, top-class tennis once again intertwines with humanitarian causes through the already well-known campaign "Ace to the Rescue", which is being held this year for the ninth time. Thanks to the long-standing support of Croatian Electric Power Company (HEP), a loyal partner of the tournament and a company that continuously invests in the well-being of the community, this valuable initiative has become an integral part of the Umag sports summer.

DODIG AND SERDARUŠIĆ MISSED THREE MATCH POINTS



Both Croatian doubles teams suffered defeats in the first round of the Plava Laguna Croatia Open on Monday, and both were close to advancing to the quarterfinals. Matej Dodig and Nino Serdarušić came particularly close, missing three match points against Monaco's Arneod and France's Guinard, including one on their opening serve. In the end, it ended 6:2, 4:6, 14-12 for the fourth seeds.


Luka Mikruta and Mili Poljič-ka, on the other hand, were defeated by American George Goldhoff and Frenchman Gregoire Jacq 6:3, 3:6, 10-7. In both the first and second sets, only one break was decisive, and in the third set the Croatian doubles team had a 5:2 lead, but then lost six points in a row.

Of the Croatian players, only Ivan Dodig remains in the doubles competition, who will play with Briton Jamie Murray.






OFENZIVA CORNER: A PLACE FOR TRUE TENNIS FANS AND SOCIALIZING WITH PLAYERS





THE ATMOSPHERE IS ALREADY GREAT, THE AUDIENCE IS ENJOYING IT

Stan Wawrinka started the match a little slowly, but we saw once again what it looks like when he loses and reminds us of the old days. It was a pretty good match from his side, especially when he took control and relaxed, then his tennis was both efficient and attractive. I think that he is also satisfied with how he played, especially since the first part of the season was not successful, he had few victories before arriving in Umag. Now he could be more and more dangerous, it will not be easy for anyone to win against him and it will be interesting to watch his performance this year in Umag.

Another reason to enjoy this match was the atmosphere. It was great. People are clearly enjoying themselves here, they came to watch good tennis, to relax, and that's what we need for the overall impression, which is already excellent. On Sunday at the start of the main tournament, we had a full stadium, and it was the same on Monday, and all of that suggests that the tournament will be well-attended again. Let me not forget, tickets for the semi-finals and finals have been sold out for some time, and that also says a lot.

On Tuesday we have two of our players in the singles competition, Dino Prižmić and Mili Poljičak, who will certainly have good support. All this is a nice touch, because we have an audience that clearly loves



tennis, so it doesn't matter if some of the announced players have cancelled, because even those who do play know how to recognize quality. We have some young tennis players who could have good careers and they are already showing it.

Dušan Lajović ended his performance early this year, but it must be admitted that he is not even a shadow of the Lajović who was the winner here. It was as if he was playing as an older brother, he was quite slow and that was not good. It's a shame for Duci, because if he had been the lucky one, I think he would have made good use of the draw.

Our boys lost their doubles, which is a shame, because both of them could have made it to the quarterfinals. They were close, especially Matej Dodig and Nino Serdarušić, who had three match points. And Luka Mikrut and Mili Poljičak were in a great position, because the 5:2 lead in the third set looked promising. Of course, such defeats hurt, because you know you had a chance, but that's part of the sport.
