





DINO PRIŽMIĆ AGAIN SUCCESSFUL IN UMAG, MILI POLJIČAK DE-FEATED



Dino Prižmić, a quarterfinalist in Umag two years ago, achieved another victory at the Plava Laguna Croatia Open and remains the only Croatian participant in both the singles and the doubles competitions. In the first round match, he defeated Dane Elmer Moller, ranked 107th in the world, 6:4, 6:2. Mili Poljičak, on the other hand, lost 3:6, 3:6 to Dutchman Jesper de Jong, and the doubles team of Ivan Dodig and Jamie Murray did not even play, as they surrendered the match owing to the Briton's high temperature.

Judging by the result, it could be concluded that Dino won in a routine way, but it was a very even match, with a great fight in almost every game. In the first set, Moller had 4:3 and a serve, but then Prižmić fought back with heart and soul and won five games in a row. The Dane broke serve again, but Dino won four of the last five games, thus achieving his first victory at the ATP tournaments this year, and the Danes now have a 0:6 record in the 35 yearlong history of the Umag tournament.

"I didn't play my best, but I tried to make the most of every moment. That was enough and I'm happy with that. There will be a similar match on Wednesday, except that the next opponent has an even better forehand and serve," said Prižmić, currently ranked 143rd on the ATP ranking list, which is his best ranking ever. He will face Georgian Nikoloz Basilashvili in the round of 16 on Wednesday evening.

De Jong served excellently against Poljičak throughout the match and did not face a single break point. He needed three breaks to win, at 4:3 in the first set and at 2:2 and 5:3 in the second set. Mili is still without a win in the main tournament in Umag (0:3), and the closest he came to passing was last year, when he had two match points against Italian Lorenzo Sonego.

"I'm not satisfied, I'm a little disappointed. I scored less than I missed. He didn't play spectacular tennis that I couldn't follow - the way I played, he just had to show up on court," said Poljičak.

Third seed Camilo Ugo Carabelli from Argentina and Pablo Llamas Ruiz from Spain, who arrived from the qualifiers, already qualified for the quarterfinals on Tuesday. Llamas Ruiz is currently ranked 537th on the ATP list, but is returning from injury – two years ago he was ranked 131st in the world.

The main draw continues on Wednesday, and it will be particularly exciting at the central stadium, as the first, second and fourth seeds will be in action. These are the defending champion Francesco Cerundolo from Argentina, Luciano Darderi from Italy and Damir Džumhur from Bosnia and Herzegovina. The final match could be a real treat, as Džumhur will face Stan Wawrinka from Switzerland.







Last night's wine evening "Hidden Charms of Istrian Wines" in the Taste Istria zone was all about sparkling wines. Sommelier Lucija Matijević was once again in charge of expert guidance, and the CUJ, Zigante Vero and Coronica wineries participated. Visitors thus had the opportunity to taste sparkling wines and discover all their nuances through a carefully designed tasting. Through a conversation with the HSK sommelier, the audience learned a number of interesting facts about the history of serving sparkling wines - from the original cup-shaped glass, which was not conducive to preserving bubbles or emphasizing aromatics, to the narrow flute that emphasized exclusively the perlage, but stifled the aromas, all the way to today's tulip glass, which ideally combines the visual impression of the bubbles and the aromatic complexity of the wine.

The tasting was conducted "blindly", and the most of the audience agreed on one wine that stood out with its balance of freshness, aromatics and neatly balanced alcohol. The tastings continue tonight at 9 pm, and the new theme will be red blends, which bring completely different, stronger and more complex wine stories.

After the third day of the main tournament, we saw the performances of all the Croatian tennis players. In the end. Dino Prižmić was the most successful, he passed, played impressively and I think he can go far. Mili did not manage to seriously threaten Jesper de Jong, as we had feared, because the Dutchman came in very good shape. Obviously, the conditions suit him here, he was in good shape, unlike Mili, who played excellently in Umag last year.


Our players are the heart of this tournament. Croatian tennis has been very well represented this year, and I hope that it will be so in the future, and that the careers of these players to whom we have given invitations will develop in the best possible way. For example, I hope that at least one of them will progress so much over the next twelve months that he will not need an invitation, but will enter the main tournament directly.

This entire generation, and I mean those born in 2004, Luka Mikrut and Mili Poljičak, and Dino Prižmić and Matej Dodig born in 2005, is certainly worth investing in. This includes Duje Ajduković, who has not been with us this year, but has played solid matches in Umag and had a victory in the main tournament. We are extremely proud that over the past ten years, about 80% of invitations have gone to our players. This year was the same, three invitations went to them, so there were the qualifications and the



doubles tournament which, I must say, ended unfortunately. Two narrow defeats and then the withdrawal of Ivan Dodig and Jamie Murray.

We are extremely proud of that. I must emphasize once again. The tournament is privately owned and not formally affiliated with the Croatian Tennis Association, but Croatian players are extremely important to us. I believe that this support, giving them the opportunity to compete in the strongest world competition, will yield results. The Croatia Open proudly bears the name of Our Beautiful Homeland.

PRIŽMIĆ IS CONFIDENT, ANOTHER BOMBER AWAITS HIM

We were waiting for a Croatian tennis player to win in the main tournament and we got it in the last match of the first round. Dino Prižmić came through, I would say in one of his classic matches. He had a bomber as his opponent, but he still moved well. There weren't many winning shots, in other words a classic match for Prižmić as he plays, but he's a fighter who knows that his opponent won't give him anything and that he has to work hard to earn the victory. He played well, he has confidence after several excellent results at the ATP Challengers and it will be interesting to see how far he can go.

His next opponent will be of a similar profile to Moller. Basilashvili is also a bomber. He had very good results not so long ago, then he fell a little, but he is coming back and it seems that he is in a form with which he can count on success. Dino will play as he knows best, and Basilashvili will do his own thing, so we will see who it suits best.

Mili Poljičak didn't make it, but what he played was nothing. You can't expect a positive result like that. De Jong is not a special class, but he has everything. He's fast, he's on every ball, he's active... You can't beat a player like that by waiting for your serve to work or something like that. It was bad, it's not a level sufficient for ATP tournaments, but the positive thing is that we know that Mili can play much better than he did now, and that this is not a



true reflection of his capabilities. The worst Mili came out on court and as such he didn't have a chance.

On Wednesday, we have a very interesting program from the first to the last match. We all somehow regretted that some big stars cancelled their performances and the impression was that no one was left, but it turns out that the situation is completely different. The best Croatian tennis player will not play on Wednesday at the central stadium, because the competition from attractive names is stronger.

There will be a lot going on, starting at 16:30 when the defending champion Francisco Cerundolo will start his first match of the year, followed by second seed Luciano Darderi, and finally a real treat awaits us at 21:00, Džumi and Wawrinka. There will be great matches on all over the place, and should not be missed. We have reached the halfway point of the tournament, we have seen who is in good form, but now is starting the part when it will get better and better.
