





DARDERI VS. TABERNER, A NEW ITALIAN-SPANISH SHOWDOWN IN THE FINAL





Italian Luciano Darderi and Spaniard Carlos Taberner will decide the winner of the 35th edition of the Plava Laguna Croatia Open on Saturday, starting at 20:00. It will be the fifth Italian-Spanish clash in the Umag finals, and the first duel between these two. Darderi beat third seed Camilo Ugo Carabelli of Argentina 7:6 (6), 6:3, and then Taberner defeated fourth seed Damir Džumhur of Bosnia and Herzegovina 6:2, 6:1.

Darderi never lost a game while serving, and the only break points he faced (two) were at 4:2 in the second set. In the first set, both men held their serve firmly (there was not even one break point), and in the tie break, Ugo Carabelli had a set point on his opening shot. Darderi won three points in a row and steered the match towards his victory.

"I have a lot of self-confidence, it's true. We train hard every day, and that's the secret as to why I've been so successful this year," said Darderi, the 46th ranked tennis player in the world, who won the ATP tournament in Bastad on Sunday and is currently on an eight-match winning streak.

He also won Marrakech this season, and only Spaniard Carlos Alcaraz has more clay court finals (four) in 2025.

Overall he is the eighth Italian in the final of a singles competition in Umag, and will have a chance to become the fourth if he wins the title on Saturday.

Taberner lost only three games against Džumhur, but the first part of the match was particularly even. In the second game, they played as many as 34 points. It lasted 24 minutes, and after losing it, Džumhur seemed to give up, and could no longer follow his opponent's rhythm. His last attempt to fight back was at 1:5, when he returned a break, but after that Taberner was untouchable.

This was the Spaniard's first semi-final at an ATP tournament, but he didn't stop there. He started the tournament ranked 92nd in the ATP rankings, and even if he loses in the final, he will surpass his best ranking ever (he has already secured 84th place).

"This is my first final at an ATP tournament and I'm very happy. I played a perfect match in the semi-final, my forehand worked superbly and I think that overall I was at a very high level. Luciano is playing outstandingly, he's a real 'fiend', I'll have to play my best tennis to have a chance," said Taberner.



JASIAK AND FABISIAK IN THE FINAL, THE DOUBLES TITLE GOES TO JOSKIĆ AND FABISIAK

Frenchman Geoffrey Jasiak, the number one, and Pole Kamil Fabisiak, the number two, will play on Saturday (16:00) in the final of the wheelchair tennis tournament on the ITF World Wheelchair Tour calendar. Both reached the final without dropping a set, confirming their status as the main favourites in this tournament. Three Croatian tennis players also competed in the singles competition, two of whom (Anto Joskić and Ante Kolunđija) passed the first hurdles, but then lost to Jasiak and Fabisiak, respectively.

In the doubles competition, however, Croatian players had much more success. Joskić and Jasiak won the title, defeating Sven Maretić (Croatia) and Josef Riegler (Austria) in the final 6:3, 6:2.







GORAN IVANIŠEVIĆ PRESENTED THE TROPHY TO THE WINNERS OF THE EIGHTH HEPI TOURNAMENT IN UMAG



The eighth edition of the HEPi tournament, which brings together partners and customers of HEP Opskrba (Supplies) from Croatia and HEP Energija from Slovenia, was successfully held on the courts of the Umag Tennis Academy, as part of the Plava Laguna Croatia Open Umag. This year's title went to the doubles team of Vanja Vitezić and Domagoj Stojanović, who celebrated in the final against Dražen Crnković and Miran Janečić with a convincing 6-2 score. Third place was taken by Mihovil Stanić and Zvonko Kožnjak, after a series of excellent matches throughout the day.

The awards to the best players were again presented this year by Goran Ivanišević, a legend of Croatian sports and a long-time friend of the Umag tournament. Along with the awards ceremony, Goran happily spent time talking and socializing with the participants, which has become a beautiful tradition of this competition.

"Congratulations to the winners on their well-deserved title! The HEPi tournament is a great story that grows year after year and brings together more and more tennis enthusiasts. HEP Opskrba hereby confirms its commitment to the sport, and I am always happy to be part of this positive atmosphere, as part of the Plava Laguna Croatia Open Umag tournament," said Goran Ivanišević.

Nada Podnar, Marketing Director of HEP Opskrba, expressed her satisfaction that the HEPi tournament has become a recognizable and important part of the Umag tournament.

POKAŽI SVOJE NAJBOLJE

ARNEODO AND GUINARD WIN THE DOUBLES TOUR-NAMENT

Romain Arneodo (Monaco) and Manuel Guinard (France) are the winners of this year's Plava Laguna Croatia Open in the doubles competition. In the final, they defeated the American-British combination of Patrik Trhac and Marcus Willis 7:5, 7:6 (2), thus winning their second joint title, after winning the Masters 1000 tournament in Monte Carlo in April. This is Arneodo's third triumph in doubles at an ATP tournament, and Guinard's second.

They started the tournament as the 13th pair in the world, for getting into the final tournament of the season, the ATP Finals, and with the new 250 points they further increased their chances of being among the top eight pairs in the world in Turin at the end of the year. Arneodo was in the final in Umag last year (his partner was Frenchman Gregoire Jacq), but then fell one step short.

In the first round of this year's tournament, Arneodo and Guinard were on the verge of elimination, as their opponents Matej Dodig and Nino Serdarušić had three match points. After that game, they have not lost a set.

Manjada by Palagius invites visitors to take a peek into the past, but through the smells and tastes of pizzas prepared according to the recipes of Istrian grandmothers. Here, every detail matters - from the long-fermented dough, through homegrown tomatoes and aromatic olive oil, to rich toppings from the local region. Manjada brings a blend of tradition and Italian charm, in a simple but irresistible street food format.

Street Food by Lukas offers a diverse menu dominated by their Istrian burger, and as well as that visitors can also sample richly filled piadine (thin Italian flatbread) and finely prepared tortillas. Each mouthful is designed



with the idea of connecting global street food trends with local flavours and ingredients.

For those who prefer specific meat snacks, Fredi's Grill offers a range of grilled dishes - from juicy steaks to marinated skewers and sausages, with side dishes that further emphasize the local character of the offer. The meat is prepared in front of the guests, which further emphasizes the freshness and quality of each bite.

A completely new concept is Naša kužina, which brings plates filled with classic Istrian dishes in a modern edition. This is the ideal stop for anyone who wants to taste the deeper roots of Istrian cuisine, but in an accessible street food festival format.

While the flavours of Istria dominate every corner of the Taste Istria zone, visitors can also enjoy a rich selection of signature cocktails and wines offered by neighbouring cocktail bars and winemakers brought together under the program "Hidden Charms of Istrian Wines". Taste Istria proves once again this year that good tennis goes hand in hand with good food, creating a unique corner where local identity, contemporary presentation and a summer atmosphere make the perfect blend of sport and enjoyment.





TUJAMO AND BABY LASAGNA SET UMAG ON FIRE, A GRAND MUSICAL FINALE WITH FEDDE LE GRAND FOLLOWS



We are nearing the end of the Plava Laguna Croatia Open, another grand finale awaits us, on Saturday between Luciano Darderi and Carlos Taberner. One of the things that marked this year's edition was the incredible attendance at the entire Stella Maris and especially the Goran Ivanišević Stadium. The match between Wawrinka and Džumhur, which brought a huge number of people to the centre, according to some data we have, actually broke some records in terms of the number of tickets sold.

All the matches that have been played, from the very first days, have been very well attended, and we certainly have to extend a big thank you to our loyal visitors to Umag. Even this year, in which let's not shy away from it - we didn't have the strongest lineup of players that we were aiming for, and so we were in some way damaged or weakened by these cancellations, we have had a fantastic turnout.

We always worry about how the first matches will go, how hot it will be and so on, but it couldn't have been better. The air temperature certainly helped us in the semi-finals, making it even easier to watch the matches. The final was sold out a long time ago and that was never in doubt. I hope the weather will be on our side on Sunday and that we will round off a fantastic week

All of this obliges us, after the finals, to continue working on the new edition of the tournament, primarily on bringing the best players possible to 2026

Looking ahead, we are changing the calendar, going a week earlier, or immediately after Wimbledon, and we will share the week with two fantastic tournaments, in Bastad, Sweden, and Gstaad, Switzerland.

This means that there will be a big fight for the limited number of players who want to be on clay after Wimbledon, but we will do our best to ensure that tennis in Umag is at this level.

For now, we still have this crucial day to enjoy what Taberner and Darderi can offer us.

THE UMAG FINAL IS ALWAYS AN EXPERIENCE, I EXPECT IT TO BE ON SATURDAY TOO

We've reached the finals, there's only one question left, Darderi or Taberner. After all, we'll have a very good final, because both of them are playing superbly and, if they repeat in the final what we have seen during the week, we'll have a great evening of tennis.

Carlos Taberner beat Damir Džumhur, in simple terms it was a "chainsaw massacre". Or another phrase from sports jargon, Džumhur did not show up on the field". I somehow thought that Taberner would be able to get a good result, but he played against the defending champion at the start and it didn't seem realistic to think that he could go far. But when he beat Cerundolo, in that marathon that lasted three and a half hours, nothing was impossible anymore.

We saw some great tennis from him, and today Džumhur's legs were just not working. And when that's the case, when he can't run, then there's no hope. After the second game, which lasted 24 minutes, it was already clear which way the match would go. Taberner took complete control and didn't lower the level of his tennis, and then the second set was pure dominance.

Darderi is a good player, we knew that, and now he is playing on the verge of the best tennis because he is full of self-confi-



dence. He came from Sweden with a title, is flying high and is showing himself in the best light. He adapted perfectly to the conditions in Umag, continued where he left off and it is clear that he is a player who, especially on clay, will have a significant role in tournaments. Not so long ago he was at the Challenger Tour, and he quickly caught up with the high-ranked players, and now he is among them. We will see what his potential is, if he can continue like this, but two tournaments won in 2025 plus this final, at worst, are not to be underestimated.

I anticipate a good final. Both are in good form, now they have confidence and a great desire to end the week in the best way. Darderi is better ranked, he has had several wins in a row because he won at Bastad, but Taberner also has some trump cards. He is also playing the best tennis of his career, which means that it can be a duel at the highest level. It will definitely be an experience, the Umag final never disappoints.
