Dino Prizmic produced an outstanding performance in the opening round of the 36th Plava Laguna Croatia Open Umag, booking his place in the Round of 16 with a commanding straight-sets victory. On the day he became Croatia's highest-ranked men's player, Prizmic defeated eighth seed Vit Kopriva of the Czech Republic 6-1, 6-3 to reach the second round in Umag for the third time in his career. Among Croatian players, only Ivan Ljubicic and Marin Cilic had previously achieved that feat.

The opening set was a one-sided affair, with the world No. 84 in complete control. Prizmic dropped his only game of the set while serving for a 6-0 lead at 5-0. Kopriva, currently ranked No. 64 in the world, regrouped in the second set but was still unable to convert a single break opportunity, despite holding a 0-40 lead in Prizmic's opening service game. The Croatian served superbly, kept his unforced errors to a minimum and secured another impressive victory in Umag, where he reached the quarter-finals in both 2023 and 2025.

Prizmic will next face the winner of Tuesday's first-round match between Alex Molcan and Valentin Royer in Wednesday's Round of 16.

"I think the first set was a combination of my excellent play and his level dropping a little. It was my first clay-court match in quite a while, so I'm pleased with how I played. Hopefully, I'll keep improving from match to match. I managed to execute most of what we had planned before the match, although I still don't feel like I'm playing my very best tennis," said Prizmic.

Elsewhere on Centre Court, Bosnia and Herzegovina's Damir Dzumhur eased past Portugal's Henrique Rocha 6-2, 6-1, while former world junior No. 1 Luca Van Assche of France staged a remarkable comeback. Facing 2019 Umag champion Dusan Lajovic, Van Assche

trailed 6-2, 4-0 before rallying to claim a 2-6, 7-5, 6-4 victory.

"I was prepared for a long battle, but fortunately it didn't last too long. That's probably for the best, because matches in these conditions take a lot out of you. That's why I never relaxed, especially after losing my last two or three matches despite being a set and a break up. It was good to get the job done in straight sets," Dzumhur said.

Asked how he felt about playing on the slightly larger Centre Court compared to last year, Dzumhur smiled:

"It suited me perfectly. I'm not going to lie – those extra two metres were a huge help. I like returning from well behind the baseline, so it definitely worked in my favour. Thanks to the organisers."

Play in Umag continues on Tuesday from 4 p.m., when Matej Dodig takes on Spain's Pablo Carreno Busta in the opening round. The Centre Court schedule will then feature Marco Cecchinato against Roman Andres Burruchaga, followed by Alexander Blockx versus Titouan Droguet.

KALENDER AND SERDARUSIC EXTEND WINNING STREAK

Fresh off their ATP Challenger title in Trieste last week, Admir Kalender and Nino Serdarusic carried their winning momentum into Umag. In the opening round of the doubles draw at the Plava Laguna Croatia Open, the Croatian pair defeated the Belarusian-Mexican team of Ivan Liutarevich and Miguel Reyes-Varela 6-4, 6-1 to book their place in the quarter-finals.

The other Croatian wildcard duo, Emanuel Ivanišević and Mili Poljicak, were unable to cause an upset against the top seeds, Czechs Adam Pavlasek and Patrik Rikl, who advanced with a 6-4, 6-2 victory.

Serdarusic and Kalender dropped serve only once throughout the match, when serving for the opening set at 5-3, but otherwise were the dominant team from start to finish. They took complete control in

the second set, cruising to a convincing victory and a place in the last eight.

Both Serdarusic (No. 112) and Kalender (No. 208) reached career-high ATP doubles rankings this week. This marks just their second tournament together in 2026, following their title-winning run in Trieste.

Top seeds Pavlasek and Rikl proved too strong for Ivanišević and Poljicak, breaking serve on three occasions to seal their place in the quarter-finals. The Czech duo, runners-up at the ATP tournament in Bucharest earlier this season, lived up to their billing as tournament favourites. For Pavlasek, the result matches his best-ever performance in Umag, while Rikl is making his tournament debut. Notably, his father, David Rikl, reached the singles final of the Croatia Open back in 1998.

HITMAKER SENIDAH PERFORMS IN UMAG TONIGHT!

On Tuesday evening, Senidah will take the stage at the Dance Arena. The Slovenian singer-songwriter has established herself as one of the most recognizable names on the regional music scene in recent years. After beginning her career with the Slovenian band Muff, she launched her solo career in 2018 with the single Sladjana, which introduced her to audiences across the region. Since then, she has released a string of hits including Misici, Replay, Balkanka, Behute and Alo Alo, blending trap, R&B, pop and electronic music into her distinctive artistic style. 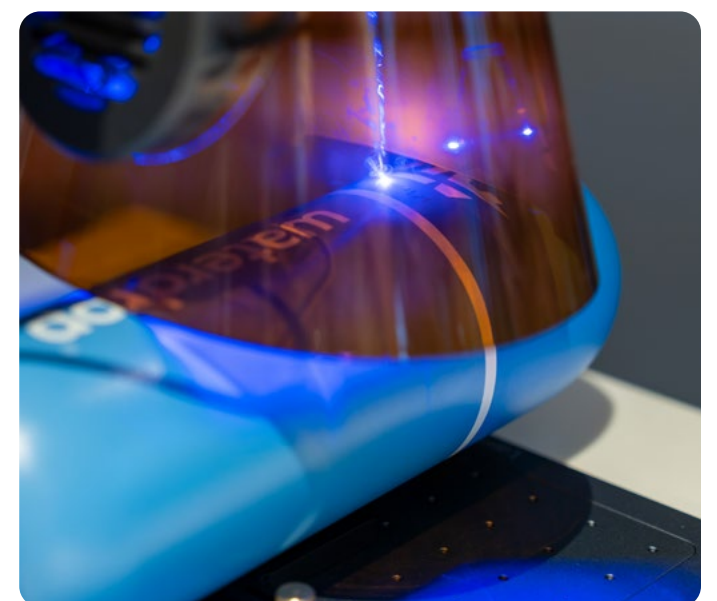

HIDDEN CHARMS OF ISTRIAN WINES RETURNS TO THE PLAVA LAGUNA CROATIA OPEN UMAG

Alongside world-class tennis, evening concerts, the Taste Istria zone and daily events on the Plava Laguna Stage, this year's Plava Laguna Croatia Open Umag once again brings back Hidden Charms of Istrian Wines, giving visitors the opportunity to discover Istria's renowned wineries and wine labels through guided tastings.

The program will take place from Tuesday, July 14, to Friday, July 17, with tastings beginning each evening at 9:00 p.m. The sessions will be led by Croatian Sommelier Club sommelier Lucija Matijevic, with the assistance of Dr. Kresimir Mikinac, Head of Education at the Croatian Sommelier Club, and sommelier Viktor Peic.

Over the course of three themed evenings, nine Istrian wineries will present wines grouped by variety. Tuesday's tasting will feature young Malvazija wines from Fiore, Zigante Vero and Frankovic. When creating the categories, we followed the principle of fairness—after competing in a category, a winery does not compete in that same

category for the following two years, making the competition even more exciting. We have also kept last year's rule that the previous winner sits out the following edition, meaning last year's champion, Rav-alico Wines, is not competing this year," said sommelier Lucija Matijevic.

For years, Hidden Charms of Istrian Wines has brought together wine tasting, education and conversations with Istrian winemakers, giving visitors the opportunity to discover different wine varieties, hear the stories behind each label and take an active role in selecting the tournament's ATP Wine 2026.

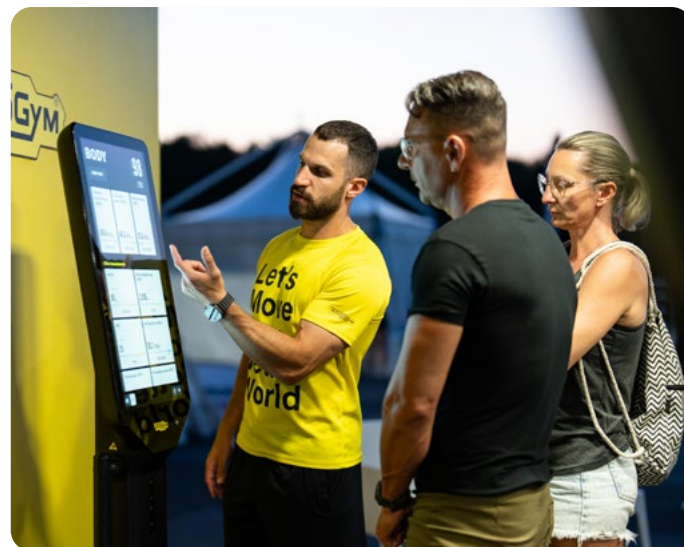

HISTORY OF THE PLAVA LAGUNA CROATIA OPEN

NINE FORMER ATP WORLD NO. 1S HAVE COMPETED IN UMAG

The inaugural ATP tournament in Umag was held in 1990, and since then the Plava Laguna Croatia Open Umag has welcomed many of the biggest names in men's tennis. Grand Slam champions, ATP World No. 1s, and some of the sport's greatest stars have all graced the courts in Umag.

For some, Umag represented one of the first stepping stones on their journey to the top of the game. Others arrived at the peak of their careers, while a number of established champions came after already filling their trophy cabinets with some of tennis' most prestigious titles.

In total, nine players who have reached the No. 1 spot in the ATP Singles Rankings have competed in Umag. The first was Austria's Thomas Muster, who captured the title three times (1992, 1993 and 1995). He was later joined by Marcelo Rios, who made two appearances, Carlos Moya, a five-time champion and 14-time participant, Gustavo Kuerten, Juan Carlos Ferrero, Novak Djokovic, Rafael Nadal, and, more recently, Carlos Alcaraz and Jannik Sinner.

The Plava Laguna Croatia Open Umag will once again host the "Ace to the Rescue" charity initiative, which will be held for the tenth time this year. 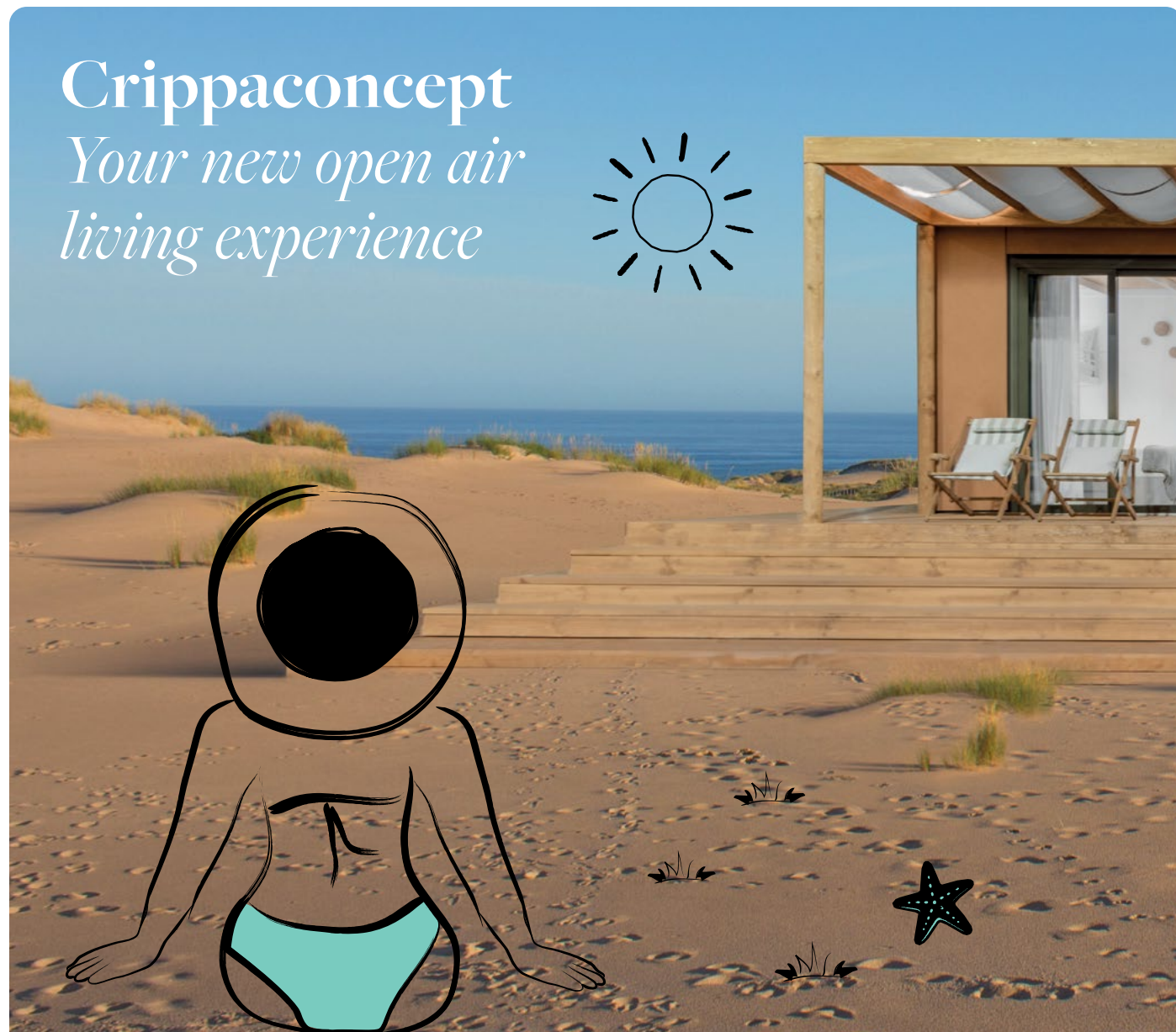
Throughout the tournament, every ace served by the players will be recorded, with the total number of aces determining the value of the donation. As in the previous seven years, HEP will direct the donated funds to the Croatian Wheelchair Tennis Association in support of the ITF tournament held during the ATP tournament week in Umag.

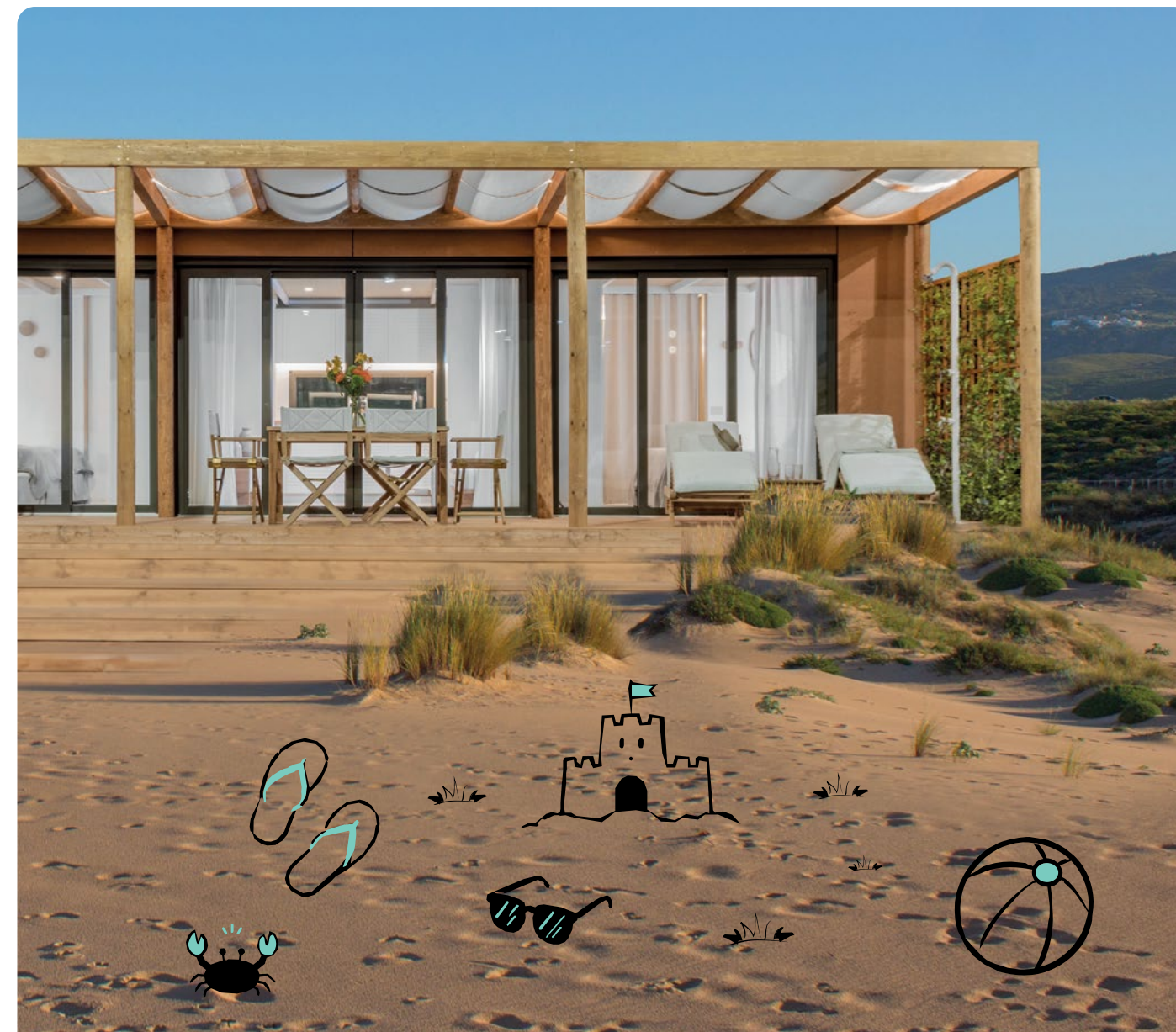
