# UNFORGETTABLE TENNIS MOMENTS IN UMAG: PLAVA LAGUNA CROATIA OPEN UMAG PROMISES ANOTHER MAGNIFICENT SPECTACLE

Just before the start of the tennis spectacle at the ATP Plava Laguna Croatia Open Umag, on 28 June, the Infobip campus in Zagreb hosted a press conference presenting the roster of players who will be competing at this year's 34th annual tournament. This amazing roster of players guarantees an exciting tournament, while visitors will also be able to enjoy an exquisite gourmet offer, and some relaxation at various concerts in the evening hours following the matches. Some of the most famous tennis names at this year's tournament are Lorenzo Musetti, who played in the semi-finals at Wimbledon, Russian Andrey Rublev, currently holding sixth place in the ATP rankings, and title defender Alexei Popyrin.

The Umag tournament has repeatedly shown that it regularly acknowledges young tennis hopefuls, such as Carlos Alcaraz and Jannik Sinner. #### ITF M15 TOURNAMENT AS AN OVERTURE TO THE PLAVA LAGUNA CROATIA OPEN



Traditionally, the Plava Laguna Croatia Open Umag ATP tournament is the central sporting event of the summer in this Istrian town, and this season it adds another sporting event – the ITF M15 – a chance for young players to win the first ATP points of their careers.

This year's 34th annual Plava Laguna Croatia Open Umag ATP tournament is once again the perfect opportunity to see some of the most successful players in action. Visitors of this tennis spectacle will get the chance to watch Andrey Rublev, currently holding sixth place in the ATP rankings, four members of the Italian national team – Lorenzo Musseti who reached semi-finals at this year's Wimbledon, as well as Matteo Arlandi, Luciano Darderi, and Lorenzo Sonego. Last year's champion, Alexei Popyrin, has returned to Umag to try and defend his title, and the tournament will also see Jakub Menšik, Holger Rune, and many others. Croatian fans will particularly cheer on the only Croatian representative in the tournament – Dino Prižmić.

Organisers wanted to make this tournament even more attractive, so they decided to include another tournament counting towards points at the ATP rankings. This is the Umag ITF M15 tournament, part of the ITF World Tennis Tour. This tournament is a chance for young players to win the first ATP points of their careers, and this move proves that Umag is the perfect stepping stone for young players, helping them join the true professionals.

Many Croatian players who went on to have an amazing career got their first opportunities at tennis courts here in Umag. Some of them were Ivan Ljubičić, Marin Čilić, and Borna Čorić. The main stage of this ATP tournament was also where some non-Croatian players had big breaks at the start of their careers, such as Rafael Nadal and Novak Đoković, while Carlos Alcaraz and Jannik Sinner are just two of the new generation players who achieved excellent results in Umag in the early stages of their careers. Thanks to the new ITF M15 tournament, there will be even more opportunities for young players this year!

"This July, Umag will be fully dedicated to tennis, and the competitions will cover diverse categories – from amateurs, to young players wanting to make a name for themselves, and players at the highest level, who can achieve great things. This made Umag even more of a global player, and I am confident that our young players will make the most of the opportunities that this ITF M15 tournament offers them," said Tomislav Poljak, Director of the Plava Laguna Croatia Open Umag tournament.

### ROAD TO UMAG BY PODRAVKA: DENI ŽMAK WINS BOTH INVITATIONS



This year's popular tournament series Road to Umag by Podravka, awarding the most successful players invitations to the Plava Laguna Croatia Open, had a new format this season. Two competitions were held, first for doubles, and then for singles, which proved to be very successful. Our players loved the new format, and the biggest winner was, of course, Deni Žmak.

He won both competitions! First, teaming up with Karlo Kajin, he won the doubles tournament held in June in Karlovac, and a month later, just before the start of the Plava Laguna Croatia Open, he won the singles tournament in Umag. This means that he received two invitations – one for the main doubles tournament, and one for the qualifiers in the singles tournament.

In the final match of the Umag tournament he won 6:4, 6:4 against Matija Pecotić. During his triumphant run in this tournament, Žmak lost only one set, in the semi-final match against Kajin. This makes him the third champion in this tournament series out of a total of four seasons, since Pecotić won the invitation twice, in 2021 and 2022. Last year's invitation to the qualifiers for the Plava Laguna Croatia Open went to Jerko Brkić.

This is the third time that 35-year-old Deni Žmak is attempting to qualify for the main tournament in an ATP tournament. In Umag in 2013, he lost in the first, and in Zagreb in 2008 in the second round of the qualifiers. He is currently unranked in the ATP rankings, as he played his last professional tournament in the singles competition in 2022 at the Istrian riviera. A few days ago, he reached the semi-finals of the ITF World Tennis Tour in Umag with Kajin.

# **UMAG DRAW INCLUDES WORLD'S LEADING TENNIS PLAYERS AND BIG TALENTS**



The main draw of the 34th Plava Laguna Croatia Open Umag ATP tournament includes several cream-of-thecrop players, as well as some who could secure their spots very soon, as well as a few experienced masters of this sport, who have already won large tournaments and held top places in the ATP rankings.

Their names were in the drawing lots held on Friday at the Social Arena, and the entire process was headed by long-standing main umpire of the tournament, Gerry Armstrong. The top of the draw, as announced, is reserved for the world's eighth ranked player, Russian Andrey Rublev, who will be spared at the start of the tournament, just like the remaining three top-seeded players. He might face Luka Mikrut in the second round, if the Croatian 20-year-old player defeats Argentinian Camilo Ugo Carabelli.

The main tournament will see at least four Croatian players, and only one of them will face a seeded player in the first round. This player is Duje Ajduković, who entered the tournament as a so-called special exception because he was unable to play qualifications for Umag due to advancing to the semi-finals of the ATP tournament in Bastad, Sweden. At Stella Maris, his first-round match will be against Italy's Luciano Darderi (fifth seed).

The rest of the Croatian players received invitations to the tournament: the previously mentioned Luka Mikrut, the 18-year-old Matej Dodig who will face a qualified player in the first round, and Mili Poljičak, who will play his first match against the Italian Lorenzo Sonego. Mili has had an amazing overture before the tournament as he won a tournament from the ITF World Tennis Tour calendar a week ago.

The second seed is Italy's Lorenzo Musetti, the third is Denmark's Holger Rune, and the fourth is the Argentinian Francisco Cerundolo. Title defender Alexei Popyrin (Australia) is not one of the top seeded players, and neither are two of the past champions of this tournament, Fabio Fognini (Italy) and Dušan Lajović (Serbia). The main tournament starts on Sunday, 21 July, and the finale will take place on Saturday, 27 July.

Just like in previous seasons, we will get to see players who are global stars, as well as those who are yet to become stars. This is what has always made this tournament special. This year, this list may be longer than before, I'd say that we had never had these many players with a genuine chance to win the title. Rublev, Musetti, Rune... certainly top this list because of their accomplishments, but players who are less-known to the local audience might pose a formidable threat. Navone, Cobolli, and Darderi are the best among them, but we shouldn't forget Menšik, Machac, and the defender of the title Popyrin...

## NO CROATIAN PLAYERS IN THE DECISIVE ROUND, LUKA MIKRUT PLAYS ON SUNDAY

None of the three Croatian players managed to place in the decisive round of the qualifiers for the Plava Laguna Croatia Open Umag, after they were all eliminated in the first round, with no sets won.

Nino Serdarušić lost 4:6, 4:6 to the Argentinian Guido Andreozzi, in what was a match between two players drawn into the qualifiers at the last minute as replacements. Nino lost his serve at an early stage in both sets and he won no break points, but everything could have changed had he taken advantage of 0-40 and another break point when Andreozzi was serving for the match at 5:4.

Matija Pecotić also lost to an Argentinian player, Marco Trungelitti (6:3, 6:3), although he started out well enough and had two break advantages in the first set. Deni Žmak, winner of the Road to Umag tournament, was defeated 6:2, 6:4 by Taiwanese Chun-Hsin Tseng, who saved two break points when he was serving for the match at 5:4.

The main tournament kicks off on Sunday, 21 July, when a Croatian representative, the 20-year-old Luka Mikrut, hits the court. In the first round, he will face the Argentinian Camilo Ugo Carabelli, whose career best is the current 96th place in the ATP rankings.
